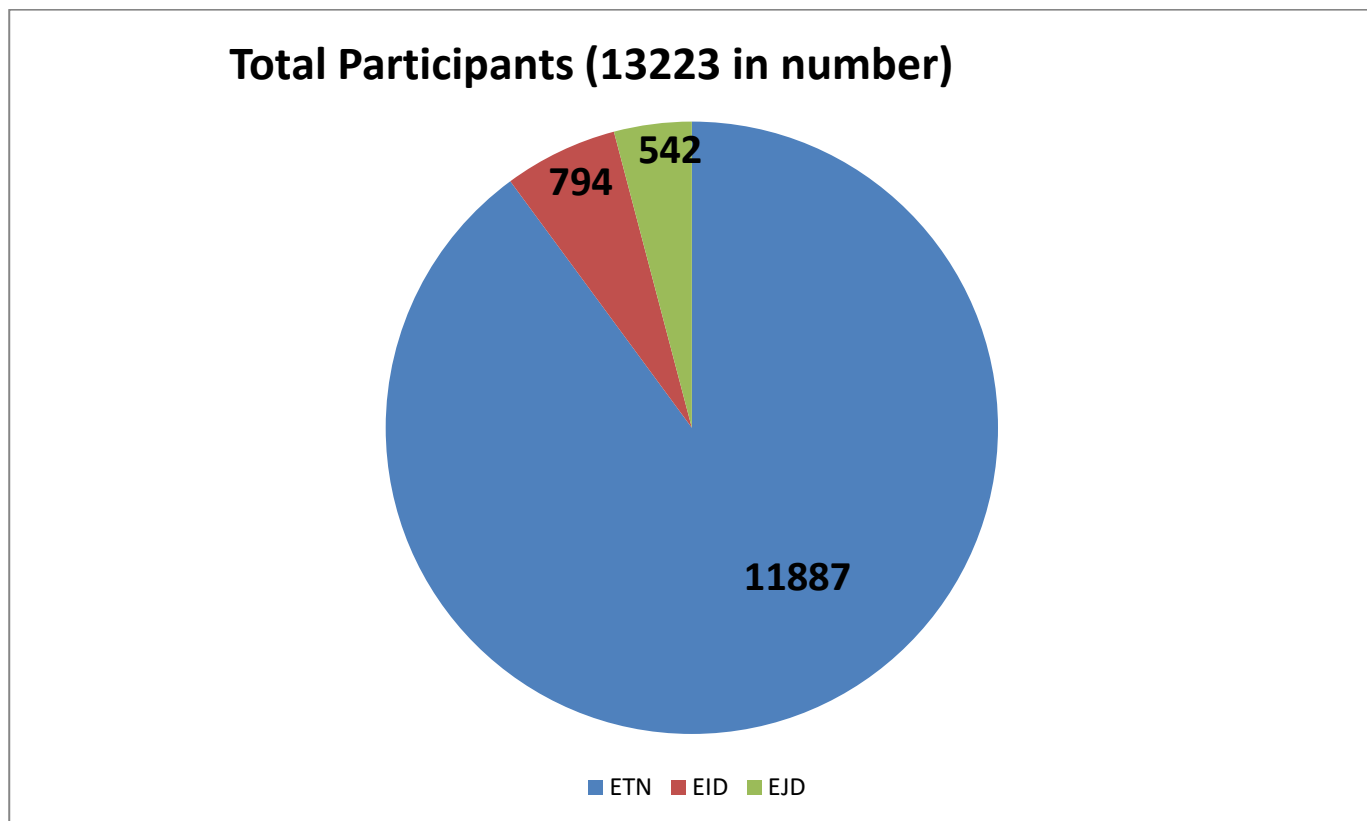

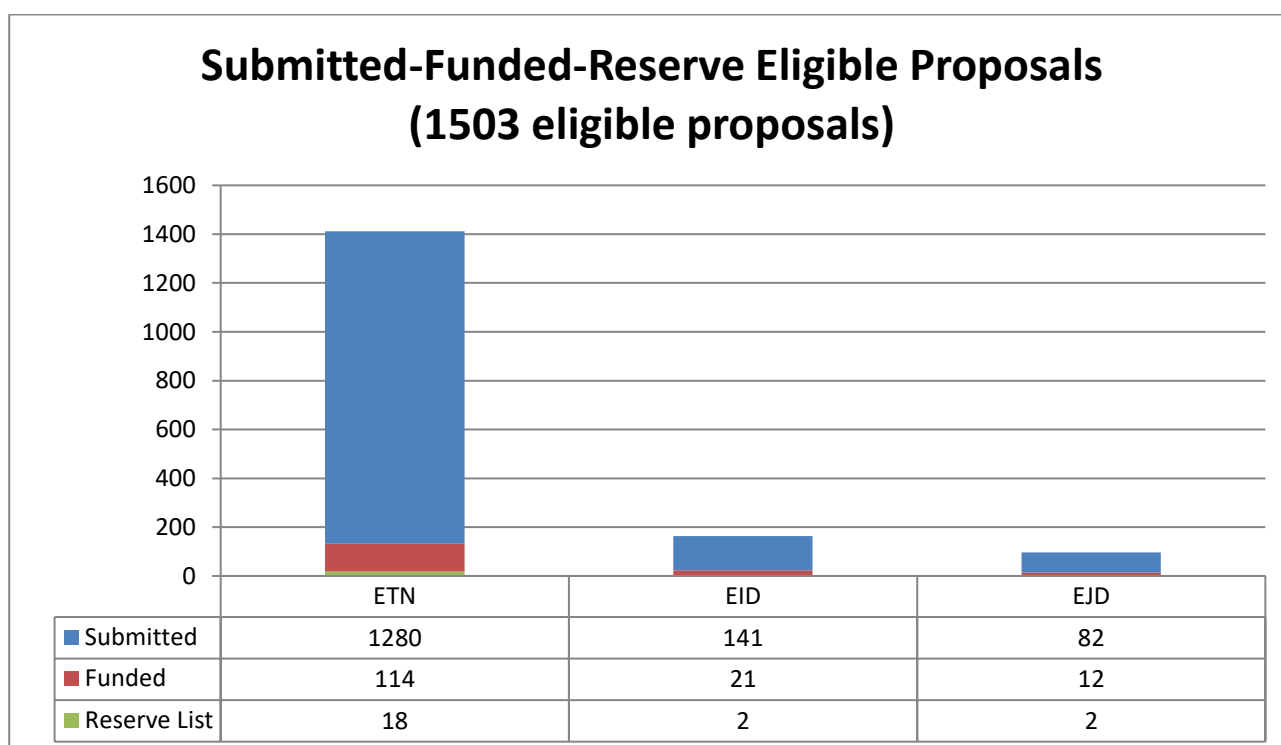

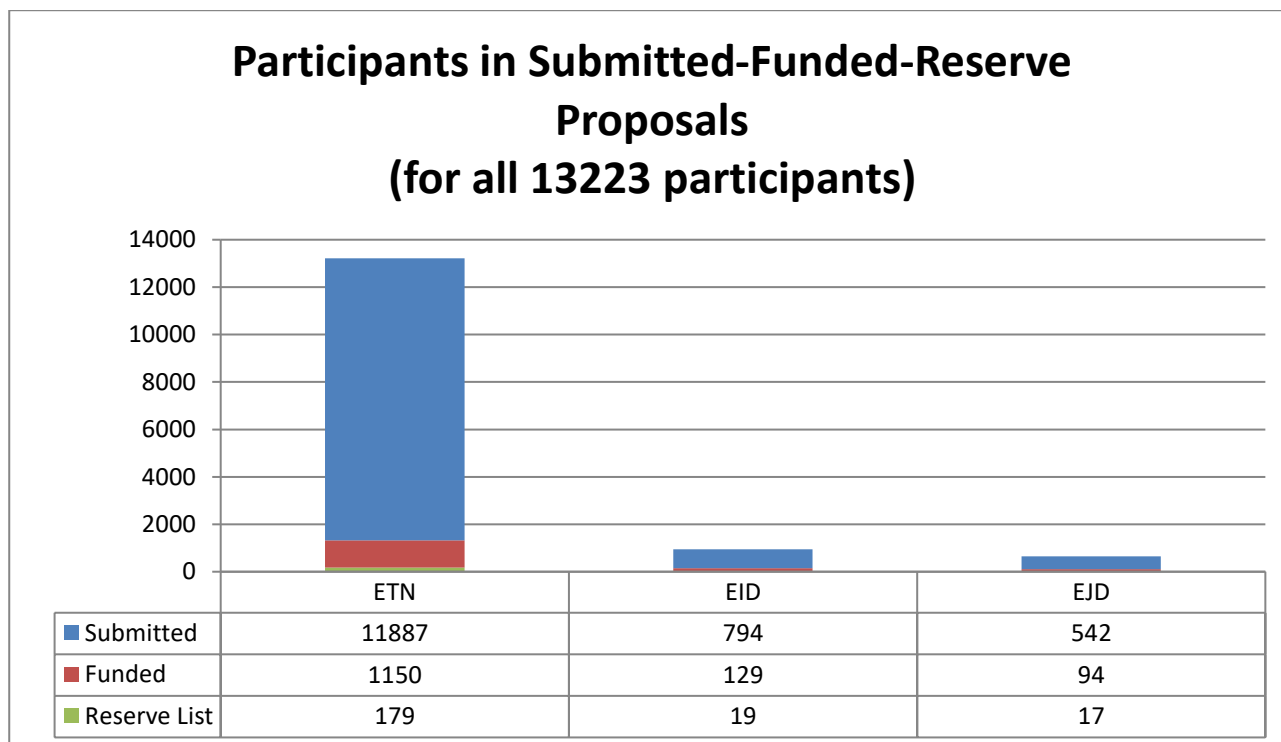

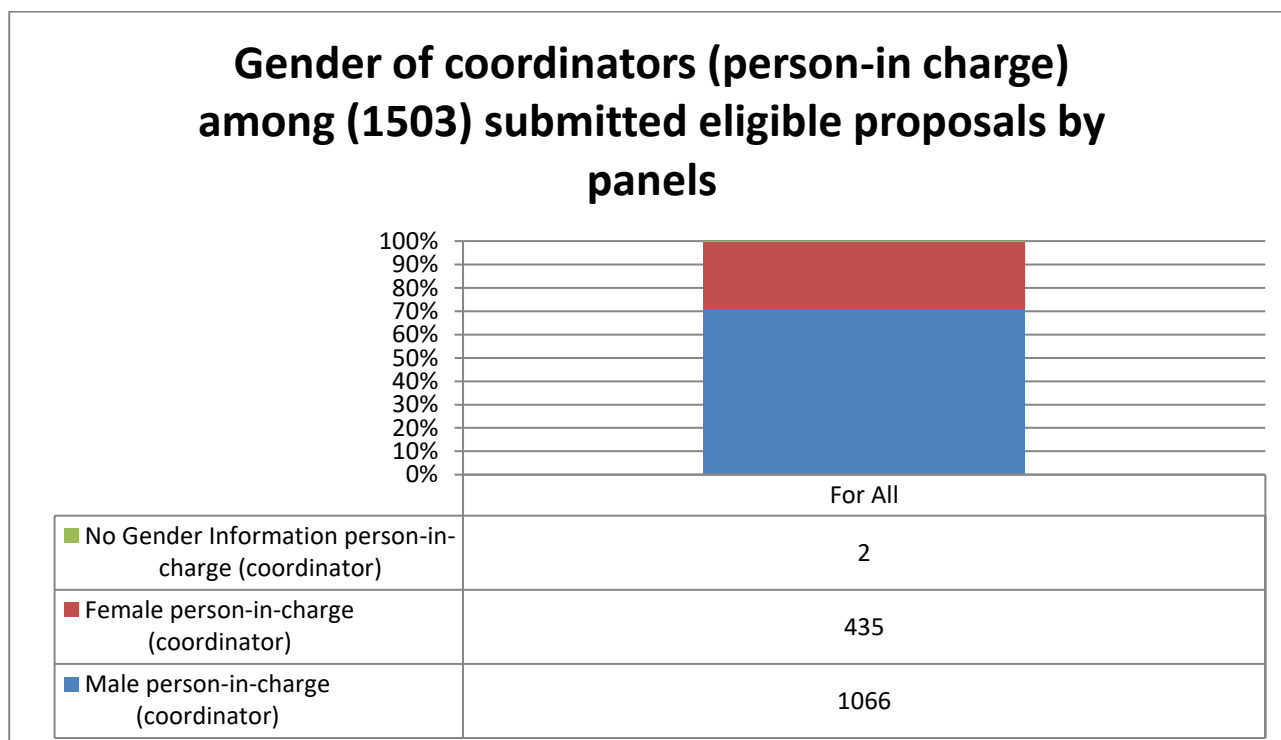

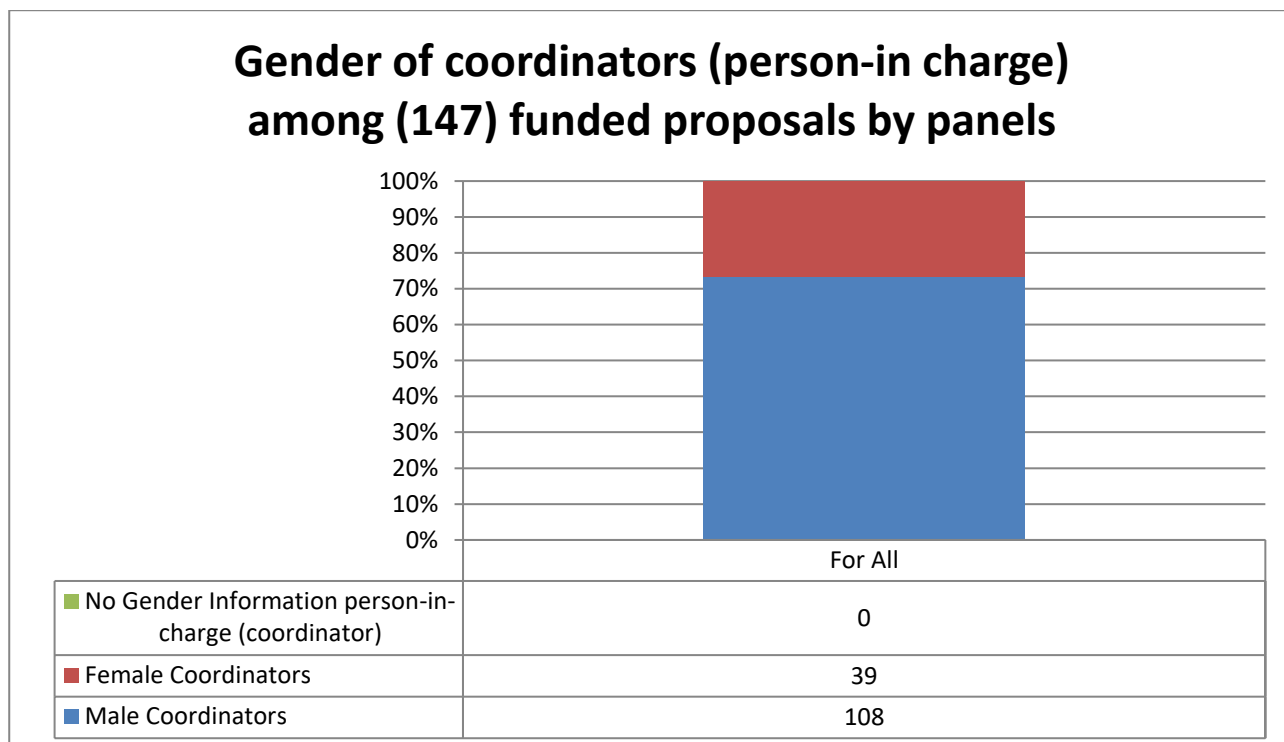

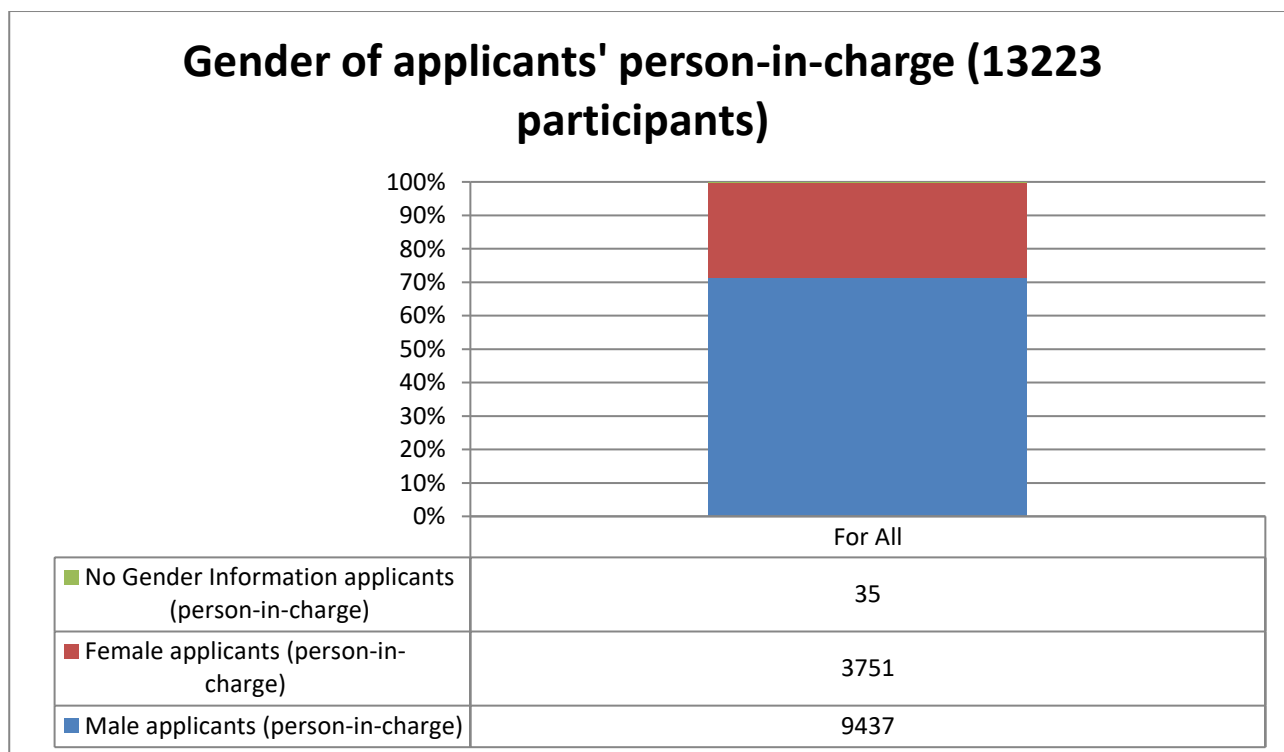
6. Gender of coordinators (person-in charge) among (1503) submitted eligible proposals by panels



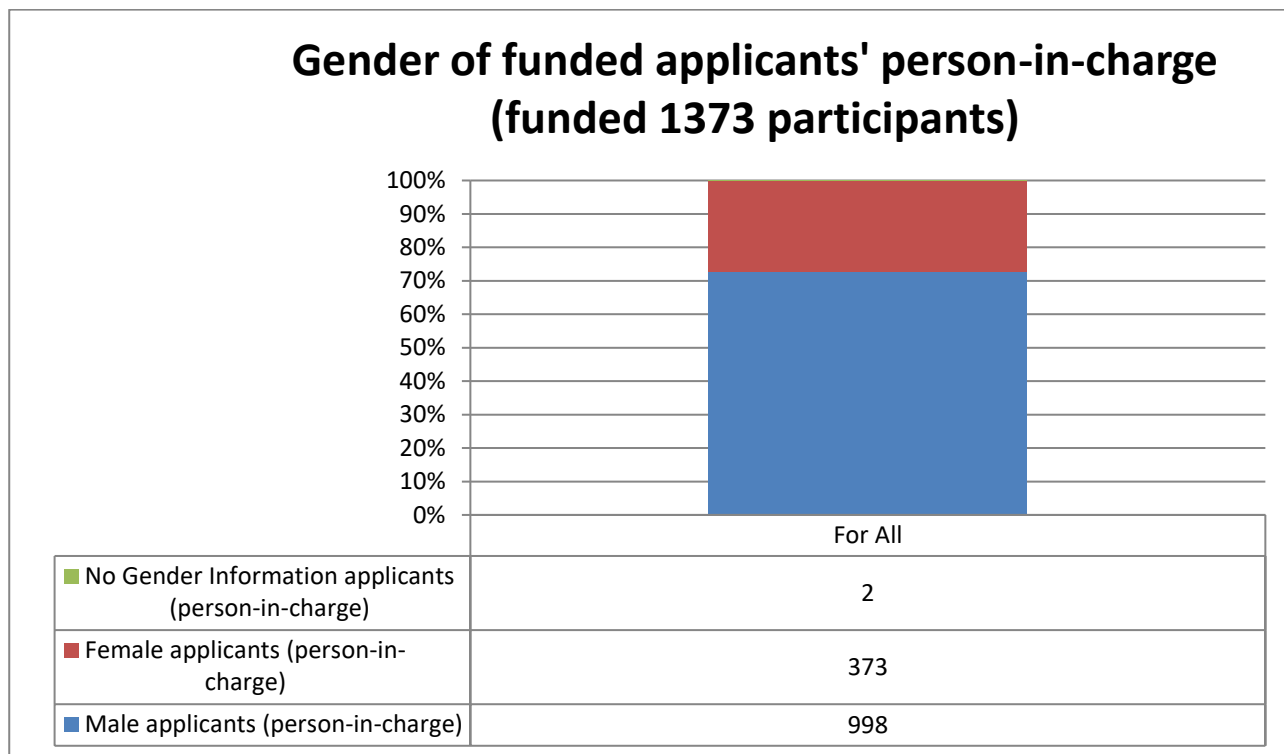
7. Gender of coordinators (person-in-charge) among funded (147) proposals by panels



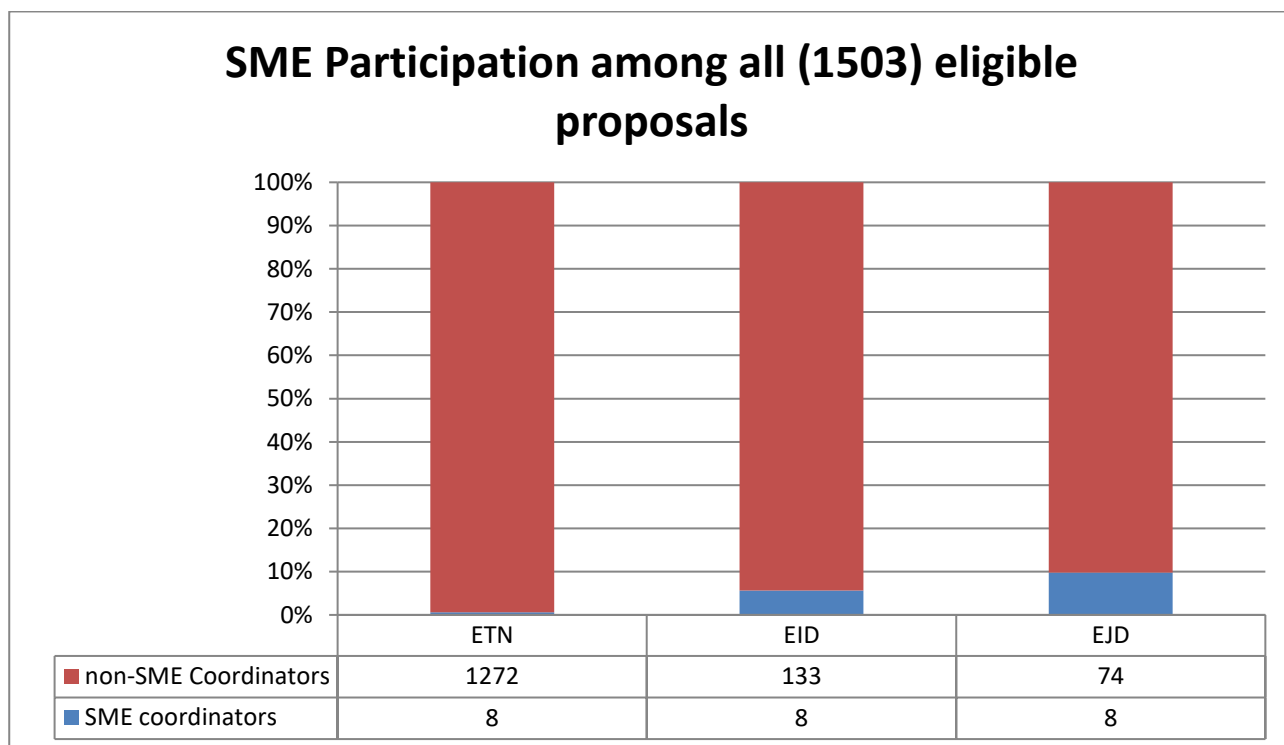

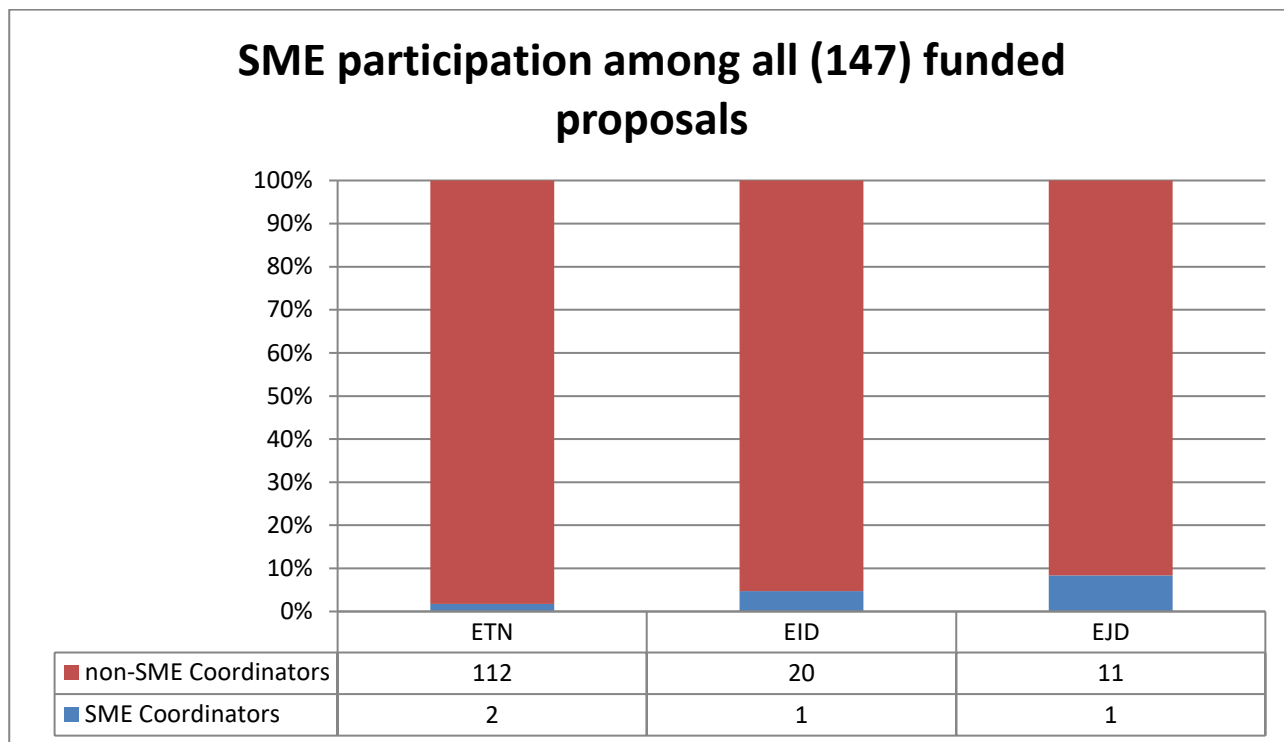

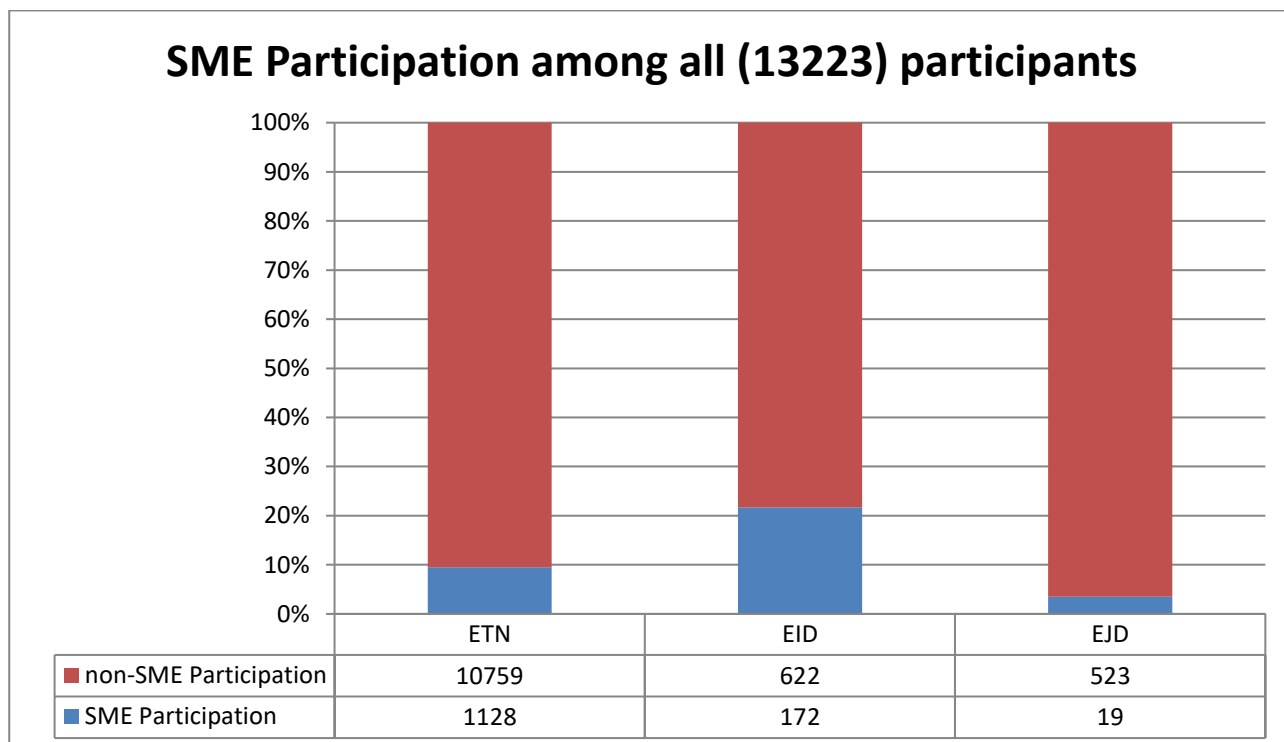

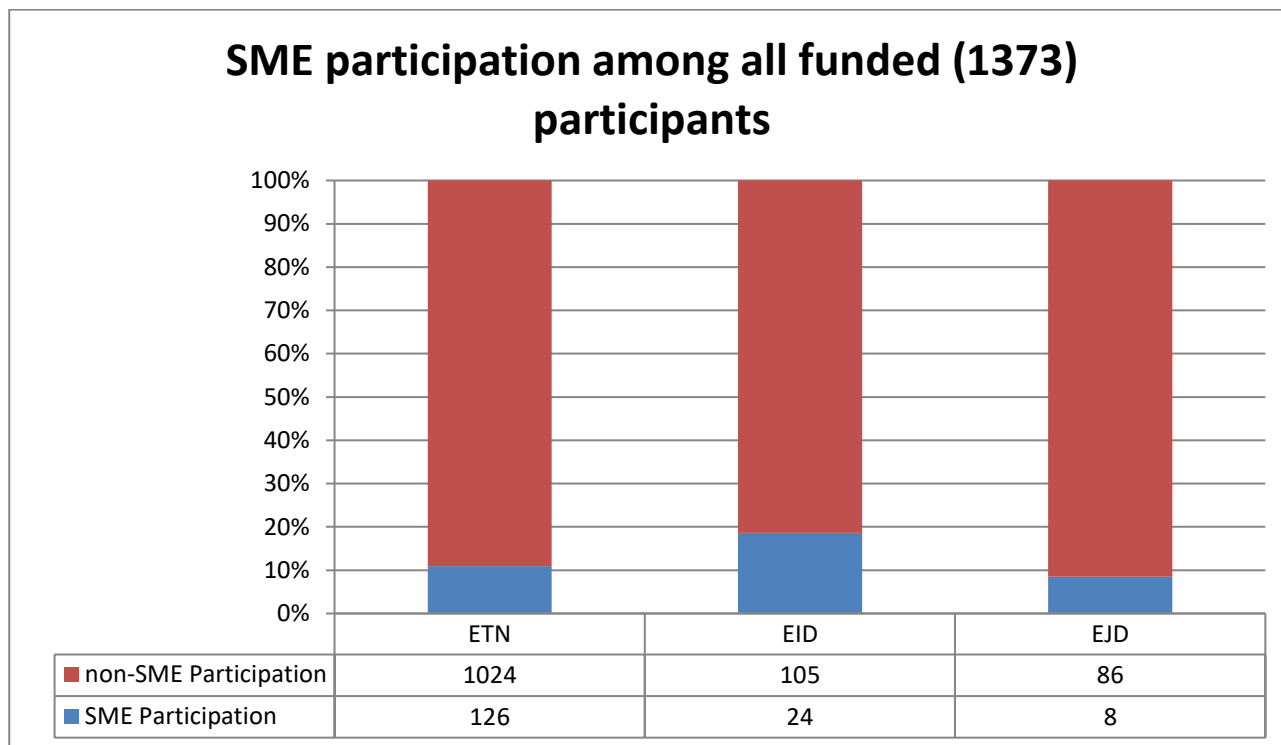

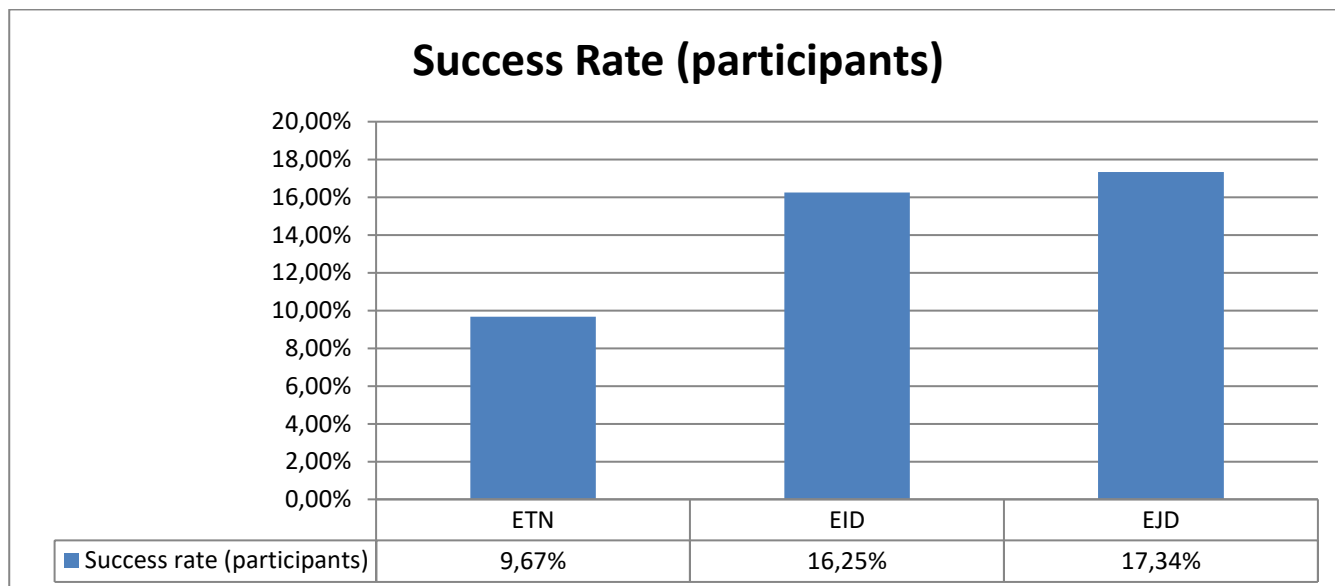

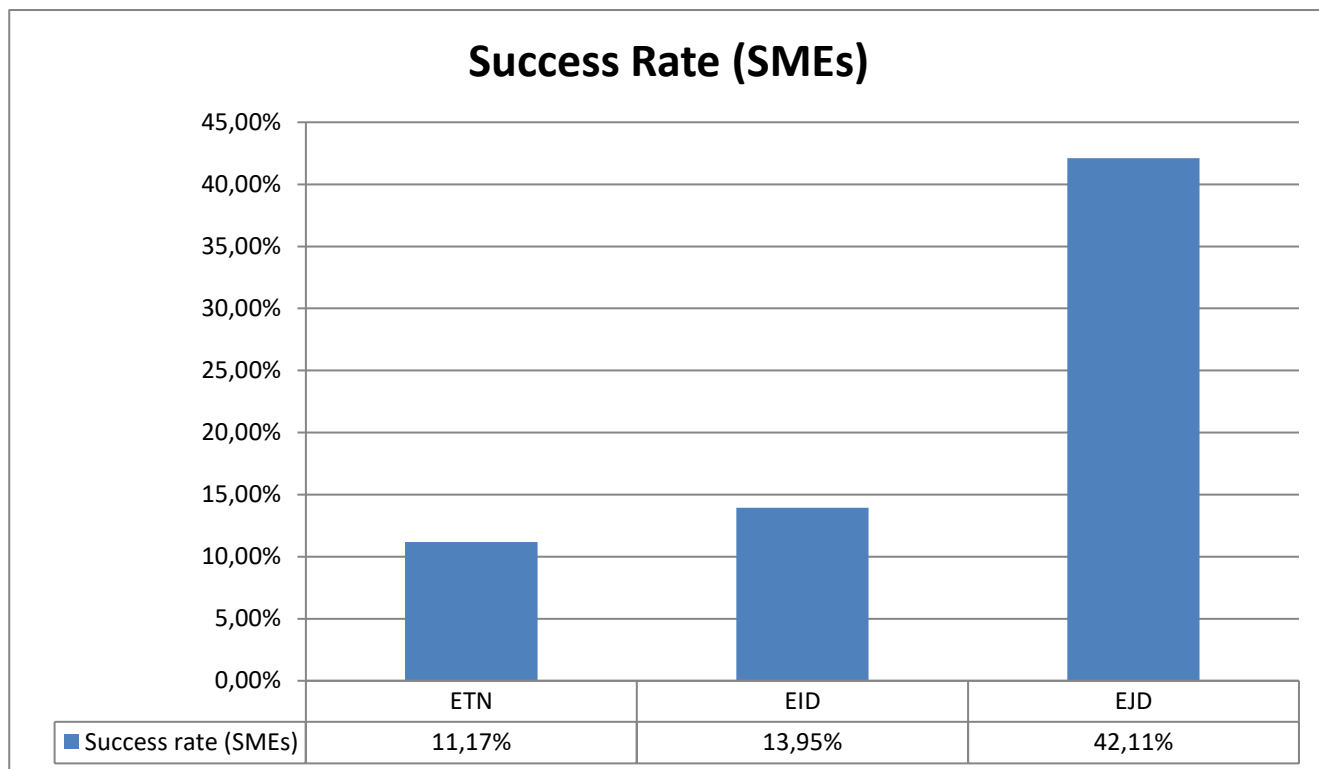

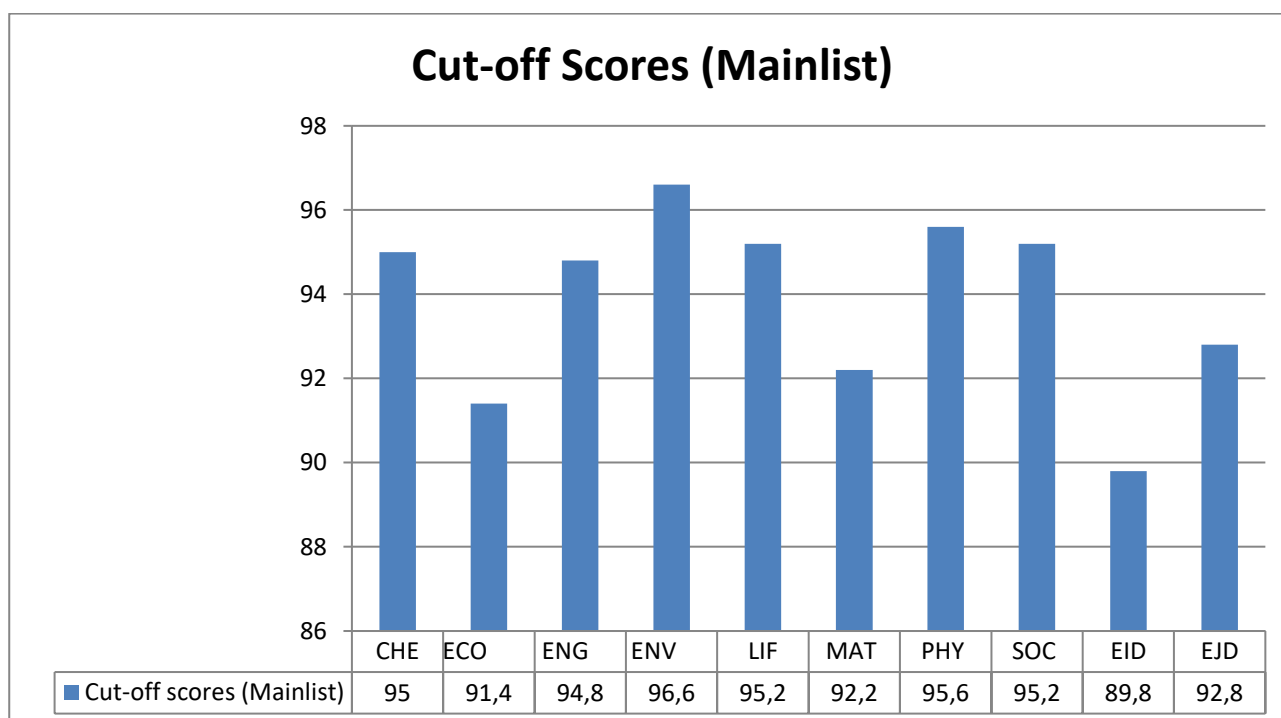

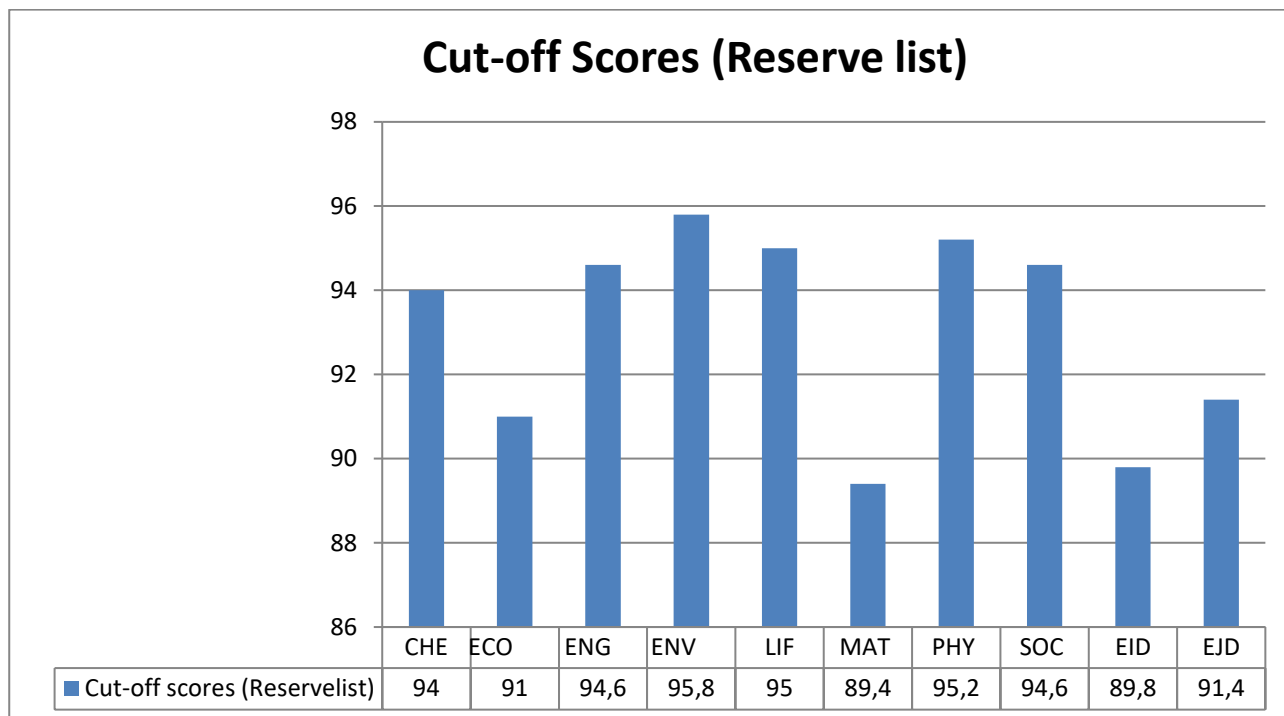

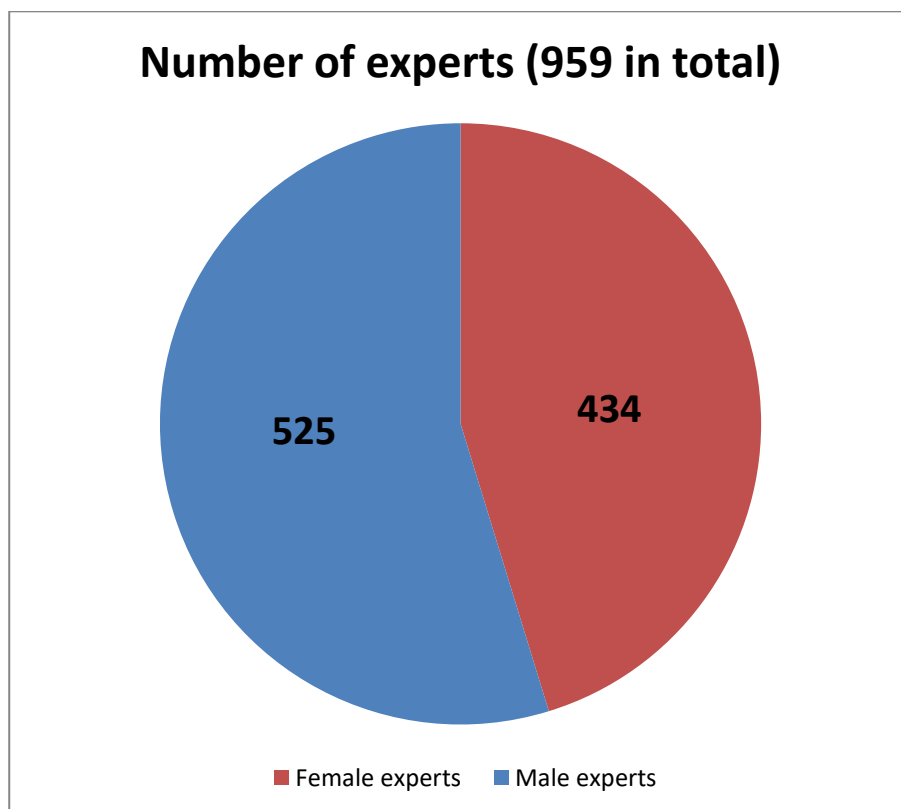
